

## AFFIDAVIT OF PETITIONER

THIS FORM TO BE USED IN EVERY CASE WHERE A PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION IS FILED UNDER SECTION 320 OF THE NATIONALITY ACT OF 1940 (54 STAT. 1148). The averments therein are required by Section 332 (b) of the Nationality Act of 1940, which provides in part that, "The applicant's petition for naturalization \* \* \* shall include averments of all other facts which may be material to the applicant's naturalization and required to be proved upon the hearing of such petition."

Three copies should be made, and one of each attached to the original, the duplicate, and the triplicate petition by the clerk of court.

FIRST.—On October 29, 1941, I filed a petition for naturalization in the court named above, and submit this affidavit, under the terms of section 320 of the Nationality Act of 1940, to be filed with, attached to, and made a part of said petition at the time said petition is filed.

(4) I am 79 years old. (5) I was born on Sept. 13, 1862 in Glan, Galway, Ireland  
(6) My personal description is as follows: Sex male, color white, complexion dark, color of eyes gray, color of hair gray, height 5 feet 2 inches, weight 110 pounds, visible distinctive marks Crippled finger, left hand, present nationality Britain, (7) I am widower married; the name of my wife was deceased Minnie we were married on Sept. 14, 1881 at Indianapolis, Indiana she was born at Madison, Indiana on Unknown and entered the United States at Unknown on Unknown for permanent residence in the United States and now resides at Unknown and was naturalized on Unknown at Unknown certificate No. Unknown; or became a citizen by birth

(8) I have 1 children; and the name, sex, date and place of birth, and present place of residence of each of said children who is living, are as follows:  
Frank Michael (m) born 1/19/85 at Indianapolis, Ind. - Now resides, Indianapolis, Ind.

(9) My last place of foreign residence was Glan, County Galway, Ireland (10) I emigrated to the United States from Unknown at New York on 1865 under the name of Michael D. Cain as shown by the certificate of my arrival attached to this petition. (11) My lawful entry for permanent residence in the United States was on 1865 on the SS Unknown

(12) Since my lawful entry for permanent residence I have not been absent from the United States, for a period or periods of 6 months or longer, as follows:

(15) I am not, and have not been for the period of at least 10 years immediately preceding the date of this petition, an anarchist; nor a believer in the unlawful damage, injury, or destruction of property, or sabotage; nor a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government; nor a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposition to organized government. (16) I am able to speak the English language (unless physically unable to do so). (17) I am, and have been during all of the periods required by law, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the United States. (18) I have resided continuously in the

United States of America for the term of 5 years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since 1865 and continuously in the State in which this petition is made for the term of 6 months at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since

and the cause of such dismissal or denial has since been cured or removed.
